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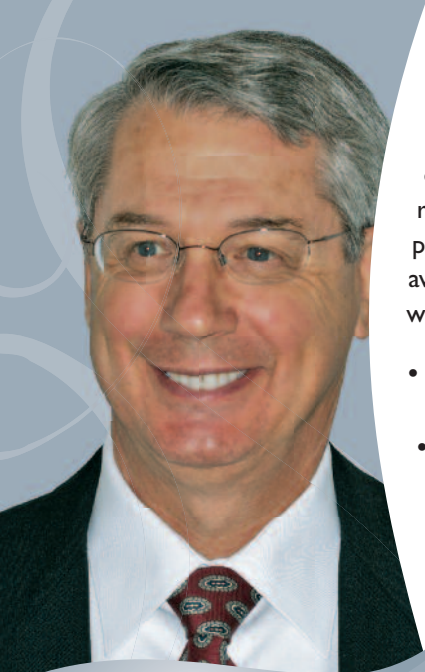

LECTURE OUTLINE—ESTHETIC INLAYS/ONLAYS

Many prominent teaching clinicians feel that inlays and onlays of whatever color are a grossly under-utilized restoration and that crowns are a grossly overutilized restoration. Esthetic, bonded inlays and onlays not only meet the demands of the restorative dentist for conservative preparation and tooth reinforcement but satisfy the growing demands of patients for esthetics. In this session, Dr. Jackson will present the indications for esthetic inlays and onlays as well as an analysis of the many different systems available in the marketplace. The clinical technique for indirect composite and ceramic inlays and onlays will be covered and include:

- **Indications/Contraindications – assuring success with**
- **The Materials – Resin/Ceramic**
- **Preparation – criteria and sequence**
- **Bonding – state-of-the-art**
- **Treating teeth with cracks and cracked teeth**
- **When to overlay a cusp and troubleshooting**
- **Repairs – Renewals**

Finally, a discussion on longevity expectations will allow the practitioner to confidently include these restorations in an esthetic restorative practice.
