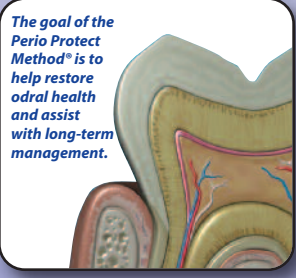
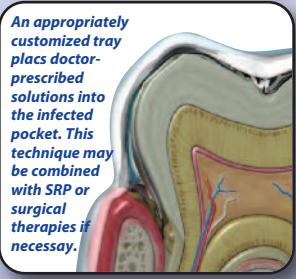
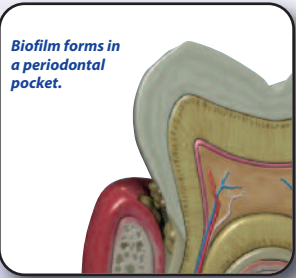
THE SCIENCE SPEAKS for itself

The Perio Protect Method® is a customized treatment to help manage biofilms in periodontal pockets. It combines the mechanical removal of subgingival biofilms (e.g. SRP) with a chemical therapy to alter the microbiological environment of the sulcus and disrupt biofilm growth. Although dentists determine the appropriate solution for individual patients, the most commonly prescribed medication is an oxidizing solution which debrides the slimy protective coating of biofilms and introduces oxygen into anaerobic pathogens can no longer survive. To deliver solutions into periodontal pockets, doctors can prescribe a customized tray. The tray places the solution in the pockets, preventing the medications from being quickly washed away.

The importance of an oxidizing agent is explained by the world's foremost biofilm expert Dr. John W. (Bill) Costerton: "When delivered deep into the sulcus with an appropriately customized prescription tray, this oxidizing agent kills planktonic cells very effectively and also kills the most exposed of the bacterial cells in the biofilms, the ones near the edges of the biofilm communities, until the communities themselves are eliminated. As the biofilm communities that cause periodontitis decrease, inflammation begins to subside, and the host has new opportunities to heal."

The Perio Protect Method® requires a doctor's prescription and supervision, but patients follow the treatment protocol at home. Re-evaluation visits are scheduled to monitor the patient's health. Doctors modify the treatment schedule as conditions improve.

Although not every patient can avoid surgery, the goal of the Method is to reduce the need for invasive procedures whenever possible. With good compliance, patients' response to treatment generally occurs within a few weeks and patient acceptance is exceptional. The Perio Protect Method® offers an easy-to-follow, comfortable treatment program and a practical homecare system for long-term management help.

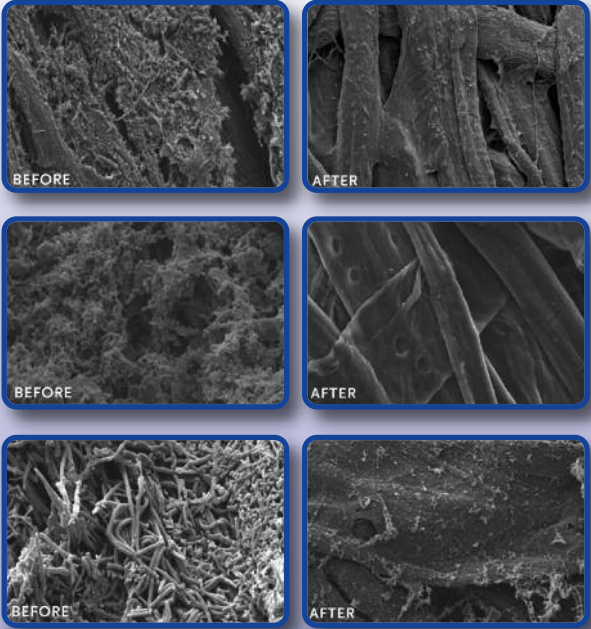


About the Speaker

As the Chief Scientific Officer for Perio Protect, LLC and a former educational officer for the IAO, Dr. Keller has been lecturing to national and international audiences for over twenty years. He has published more than 35 articles in professional journals, most recently in the Journal of the American Dental Association, and has patented numerous dental appliances and treatment methodologies. In 2004, the FDA cleared his Perio Tray® for the placement of doctor-prescribed medications into periodontal pockets.

Images from a scanning electron microscope illustrate the effect of the Perio Protect Method® on subgingival biofilms.



Paper point sample biofilm formation in a periodontal pocket before treatment. After treatment with the Perio Protect Method® the paper fibers are clearly seen and oxidized remains of biofilms are evident.
